CAA Trophy Process

First – discount any recordings of fish not caught in ACT or local regional NSW waters, ie Regions 3 and 4 as defined by the NSW Council of Freshwater Anglers

Identify winner of Lyle Knowles (for 2013 this is not being awarded) – one fish would have been eligible for Mick O'Brien or Mick Cornick or Junior Trout Trophy

Identify winner of Anglers Art – Best trout on an outing other than Lyle Knowles (for 2013 this is Kelly for her 52cm brown on fly during the Buckenderra outing 22/23 Jun 2013) – this is eligible for consideration for one of Mick O'Brien or Mick Cornick (or for Junior Trout Trophy except Kelly's not a Junior) however in 2013 it was beaten by a better fish

Identify winner of Mick Cornick – Best Trout on Fly from streams (for 2013 this is Peter for his 61cm Brown on nymph from the Eucumbene River on 4 Jun) – this fish is now not eligible for Mick O'Brien but would be considered for Junior Trout Trophy as it wasn't a Lyle Knowles or Anglers Art winner except Peter is not a junior

Identify winner of Mick O'Brien – Best Trout Any Method (for 2013 this is Peter for his 58cm Brown on nymph from the Eucumbene River on 4 Jun) – this fish would be considered for Junior Trout Trophy as it wasn't a Lyle Knowles or Anglers Art winner except Peter is not a junior

Identify winner of Best Trout by Junior (for 2013 this is not being awarded as there were no juniors registering fish) – eligible trout can also win either of Mick Cornick or Mick O'Brien but not if also awarded one of the outing trophies

Identify winner of Keith Shields – Best Native Fish (for 2103 this is Jason Q for his 66cm Murray Cod on fly from the Murrumbidgee River on 8 May)

Identify winner of Carp Challenge – (for 2013 this is Jason Q for his 84cm Carp on fly from "CBR RUNOFF" confirmed as Ginninderra Creek on 4 May)

Identify winner of Saltwater – this is decided by the membership taking part in the outing to agree on which is the best fish, ie where different species mean that length is not a reliable indicator (for 2013 this is Owen with his bag of 8 fish including 54cm Salmon and 46cm Tailor)
